2.2 Stake Classes

Pay Outs for the following Stake Classes are 1st-4th: With a 40%, 30%, 20%, 10% payout.

Horses must enter & show the corresponding ApHC class to be eligible.

I.e.: For a Halter Stake Class for example horses must be entered and show in a corresponding halter ApHC halter class such as weanling, yearling, two year old, three year old or aged -Stallions, Geldings or Mares, youth or nonpro geldings or mares or most colorful-open, youth or nonpro.

\$20 entry fee (\$10 dollars from each entry goes back into the pot).

Entry fee \$20.00, 100% entries to pot to be split,

Open Most Colorful Calcutta Notes:

*Owners a **\$10 stake class entry fee** (includes all judges) buys you a bid sheet for your horse and a **20%** cut of the final purse should your entry win. **10%** if your 2nd.

Owners, in order for your entry to be eligible, your horse must receive the minimum \$25.00 silent auction calcutta bid.



*Calcutta bidders, your winning bid will not only support your local AHAA association but it has the potential to return to you **40%** of the final purse should your "horse" win! **20%** if your 2nd. (Bids start at a **\$25.00** minimum).

*Plus a paying **WILD CARD!** Names of all stake class entries will be drawn from a hat prior to the start of the Most Colorful for an additional Wild Card payment. Of the final purse, **5%** to the winning bidder and **5%** to the owner of the WILD Card horse. The Wild Card will name will be held in a sealed envelope until the placings of the most colorful stake are calculated. It will not be opened until the 1st & 2nd place winners are announced. A bonus shot at cash for your supportive Stake/Calcutta \$\$\$\$\$. All paid entries into the Stake Class are eligible for the WILD CARD, regardless of their final placings.

Note that stake entries **will close** at 1hour prior to the start of the show. **Calcutta bidding opens Friday evening at 8:00pm** and **closes** at the **start of the halter classes on Saturday**. Entries and Bid monies to be paid prior to end of show on Saturday so the full purse can be calculated. Winner and 2nd place horse to be decided from an average of the all judges placings in the OPEN MOST COLORFUL AT HALTER CLASS. Winners of the stake/Calcutta to be calculated on Sunday following the halter. Placing and payouts to be announced there after (along with the revealing of your Wild Card winner).

Your bid sheet has a 20cm/7" by 9cm/3.5" space to add a photo of your horse (If you enter at the show you will have to bring your own photos to attach to your bid form). Be sure to supply a brief bio of your horse for the bid sheets. Only images that fit within that spot will be allowed. You can choose to bid on your own entry if you like, or bid on several entries.

2.6 Additional New Classes & Updates

All Breed Youth

- There is no cross entry for individual horse/exhibitor combinations between the All Breed Youth Classes and ApHC-Youth, Novice Youth, Youth Walk Trot classes (Excluding ApHC youth Halter, Youth Most colourful and Youth Hunter In Hand Classes).
- A horse may be shown in both All Breed Youth and ApHC-Youth, Novice Youth, Youth Walk Trot classes by different exhibitors but if an individual horse/ exhibitor combination enters an ApHC-Youth, Novice Youth, Youth Walk Trot class (excluding ApHC youth Halter, Youth Most colourful and Youth Hunter In Hand Classes) they may not participate in any classes within the All Breed Youth Division.
- Any entry in any combination may cross enter into the All Breed Green Horse/Green Rider WalkTrot Western Pleasure and All Breed Green Horse/Green Rider WalkTrot Hunter Under Saddle

2. RECORD KEEPING AND VERIFICATION

- a) Result tabulation will be available for inspection by any AHAA member/Show Exhibitor upon reasonable notification to the Awards Committee and upon mutual agreement of appropriate arrangements.
- b) Records will be kept for at least one full year pending any discrepancies or grievances.
- c) On the closing date, all results will be tabulated and totaled. Any discrepancies will be handled and verified within one (1) week of the closing date.



3. GRIEVANCES

- a) Grievances will only be accepted in writing with a non-refundable \$100 fee submitted to the AHAA President.
- b) Grievances must be filed no later than 15 days after the AHAA show in question.
- c) Any conflict concerning result tabulation and/or declaration of Alberta Champions will be settled by the current AHAA Board of Directors and the decision made will be final.

4. TABULATIONS

- a) All Youth and NonPro categories: Tabulations are based on individual horse/rider combinations.
- b) All Open categories (All Ages, Junior, Senior, Hackamore/snafflebit: Tabulations are based on individual horses, with any rider combinations.

High Points & Reserve High Points are to be presented at each of the AHAA sponsored show circuits. AHAA sponsored shows ran independently by others are not within the scope of the AHAA Show Circuit Awards rules. The following divisions will be awarded: Halter Horse, Junior Horse, Senior Horse, NonPro, Novice NonPro, NonPro Walk Trot, NonPro Masters, Youth, Novice Youth, Youth Walk Trot, Cattle Horse and NonPro Cattle Horse (where applicable).

5. If exhibitors wish to make changes to their entries, they may do so by filling out individual class correction forms, indicating additions, scratches, or change of exhibitor. Scratches/Additions.
Additions: Classes may be added up to 2 hours before the class (no post entry fee will apply if the horse was registered prior to **August 8, 2015**) Announcements will be made at the show for entry cutoffs. Regular entry fees apply to all added classes. "Add Forms" must be filled out at the show office. No additions will be accepted without the completed form. **Scratches:** After **August 8, 2015** to prior to the start of the show – scratches will be accepted for a full refund only with a veterinary certificate. Once the show commences, scratches will be also accepted at the show office, however no refund will be issued unless a veterinary certificate is provided at the show to the show office.
6. In cases of classes with posted order of performance, any horse missing its turn will be eliminated from that class unless otherwise arranged in advance. A working order may be drawn for all individual work classes including Halter. Use of working orders will be at show managements discretion.
7. A \$50 NSF charge will be charged on all cheques not honored and failure to clear the debt promptly may result in suspension from the ApHC.
8. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will allow their horses to be tested.
9. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** Original papers or current photocopy (front & back) must be presented with all entries. Master registration form must show owner exactly as listed on the papers. Non pro and Youth exhibitors must produce registration papers showing ownership or proving approved relationship to the owner.
10. **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** Every person competing in an AHAA approved show must possess a current membership card for their points to count for the AHAA year end awards. If the exhibitor wishes to enter the ApHC approved classes they must possess a current individual ApHC membership card, or ApHC membership card with Non Pro/Youth privileges, recorded solely in their name, or must complete a membership application and pay at the show, which will be submitted with the show roster. Show management must inspect this membership card or photocopy of it at any show the exhibitor has entered.
11. **EXHIBITOR NUMBERS:** Each horse will be issued an exhibitor number at the show.
12. **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:** When an exhibitor, owner and/or his representative acting on behalf of the exhibitor is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of a horse while on the show grounds, the Show management, at its sole discretion, may suspend such individual(s) from competition and a report will be forwarded to ApHC. No refund of entry fees will be made.
13. Youth or Non Pro classes will automatically be combined if there is not a point class in 1 division. The classes that are combined will be run at the time the Youth/ Non pro classes would be scheduled
14. **HIGH POINT AWARDS:** In order to qualify for a high point award exhibitors must show to all judges. Points will be tabulated throughout the show. See above entry form for information on awards and awards tabulations. (Ties will be decided by the participant with the most 1st place achievements)
15. Haul in/grounds fee will be applied to those horses that are not stabled at the event. See above entry form for more info.
16. **RV PARKING:** See online entry form for more information.
17. **ARENA USE:** The indoor arena and wash rack will be available for use on Friday evening.
18. (See ApHC Rule Book for more information) In order to be eligible to show in novice non-pro classes, the non-pro must have fewer than 20 points (including points earned in non-pro, novicenon-pro, 35 & over non-pro, masters non-pro, youth and novice youth divisions) in that class in the ApHC and/or any other breed association as of January 1 of the current year and must not have won an ApHC non-pro National or World title or title in any other equine breed association (ie: ApHCC, AQHA, APHA) in that class (beginning 1/1/1996). In addition, **former professionals reclassified as non-pros are ineligible to compete in any novice classes.**

To be eligible to show in a novice youth class, the youth, as of January 1 of the current year, shall have earned less than a combined total of 20 points in the ApHC and/or any other breed organization –approved or –sponsored shows in the group of youth and novice youth classes that count toward

determining novice eligibility in each of the five novice youth classes, excluding walk-trot, leadline, hunter in hand and halter. The youth must not have won an ApHC youth National or World title or title in any other equine breed association (ie: ApHCC, AQHA, APHA) (beginning 1/1/1998) in that class to remain eligible. Youth may be ineligible for one class (based on points or titles earned) but may still be eligible to compete in other novice youth classes.

- If you are showing in NOVICE classes you **must** provide a copy of your **verified eligibility** to the show management.
