Attire and tack should be clean and presentable. Silver equipment is discouraged and will not count over a good working outfit. No tail extensions, hoof polish or braided or banded manes allowed.

2.6 Grassroots Classes

Grassroots classes are for exhibitors that have NEVER earned breed show points. Any Breed. Exhibitors do not have to own the horses that they are exhibiting. There is no cross entry into the ApHC classes but Grassroots Exhibitors may cross enter into the All Breed Classes.

2.7 Additional New Classes & Updates

All Breed Classes

- Cross entry for Appaloosa (ApHC exhibitors) is allowed into the All Breed Classes.
- In the All Breed Youth Halter, youth exhibitors under 10 years may show accompanied by an adult if necessary for safety. Adults are not handle the horse in any manner unless safety risk. Goal of the All Breed Youth is to encourage

4.1 Show Circuit Awards Offered

The following High Point & Reserve High Point Awards and Champion Awards will be present according to the 2018 AHAA Awards Rules/Requirements.

Current AHAA membership is required by all owners, riders/exhibitors and handlers.

4.3 Awards Rules & Tabulations

2018 YEAR END AWARD RULES

All Year End Awards offered are contingent on sponsorship.

1. ELIGIBILITY

- a) Horse must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) at the time of competition and/or trail ride.
- b) **Current AHAA membership is required by all owners, riders/exhibitors and handlers.**
- c) Youth and Non-Pro riders and handlers must be AHAA members to be eligible for Youth and Non-Pro rider/handler Awards (eg. equitation, showmanship).
- d) All owners listed on the horse's registration paper, lessees, handlers and riders must be AHAA members for the horse to be eligible to receive horse awards (eg. Junior Trail, Senior Hunter, Youth Reining, Non-Pro Reining, Halter).
- e) To be eligible for any AHAA Championship Class Award contenders must earn at least one AHAA point.
- f) Division High Point Championships will be awarded where entries warrant and will be at the discretion of the current Board of Directors. A minimum of 5 AHAA points must be earned by the leading horse/exhibitor in order to be considered an eligible competitor.

2. TABULATION OF POINTS

- a) Tabulation begins on the date in which the AHAA membership was purchased (not automatically the start of the start of calendar year).

b) Youth and NonPro qualifications:

- i) Points earned in the non-pro and youth divisions are to be based on individual horse/rider combinations in all categories and for all awards
- c) Deadline to receive results/forms for tabulation in the AHAA office is September 30.
- i) Show points will be tabulated from the show results (copies of the official ApHC judges cards) provided by the show secretaries to the AHAA.
- ii) Open/All Breed Competition points will be tabulated from the AHAA Open/All Breed Competition forms.
- iii) Trail Riding - distance will be tabulated from the AHAA Trail Riding forms provided by the rider to the AHAA (in case of a tie in distance, the rider participating in the most AHAA approved or co-approved trail rides will be declared the winner).
- e) Failure to submit results by September 30 will render those results ineligible.
- f) Points will be tabulated in accordance with the attached point system.
- g) The recorded owner must provide a photocopy of the registration papers, front & back, with the results/forms by the September 30 deadline in order for the horse to be eligible for the Open/All-Breed Competition and/or Trail Riding championships.
- h) Only points earned at AHAA approved shows or AHAA approved trail rides, will be tabulated for AHAA Championship awards.

3. RECORD KEEPING AND VERIFICATION

- a) Result tabulation will be available for inspection by any AHAA member upon reasonable notification to the Awards Committee and upon mutual agreement of appropriate arrangements.
- b) Records will be kept for at least one full year pending any discrepancies or grievances.
- c) On the closing date, all results will be tabulated and totaled. Any discrepancies will be handled and verified within one (1) week of the closing date.

4. GRIEVANCES

- a) Grievances will only be accepted in writing with a non-refundable \$100 fee submitted to the AHAA President.
- b) Grievances must be filed no later than 30 days after the AHAA Annual Awards presentation.
- c) Any conflict concerning result tabulation and/or declaration of Alberta Champions will be settled by the current AHAA Board of Directors and the decision made will be final.



AHAA HIGH POINT DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS

Note: All High Point Championships presentations are contingent on sponsorship of each title and the existence of an eligible competitor.

A minimum of 5 AHAA points must be earned by the leading horse/exhibitor in order to be considered an eligible competitor.

5.0 SHOW RULES

Show Rules:

1. ApHC rules will apply to all classes according to the 2018 official handbook.
2. **ENTRY DEADLINE** – See online entry form. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS ON ALL ENTRY FORMS.**
3. **CATTLE CLASS ENTRY DEADLINE** – See online entry form – Entries may be accepted after the deadline if additional cattle are available. Final determination to be made by show management.
4. **ONLINE ENTRY DATE** – ONLINE Entry Deadline **July 30, 2018.**
5. If exhibitors wish to make changes to their entries, they may do so by filling out individual class correction forms, indicating additions, scratches, or change of exhibitor. Scratches/Additions.
Additions: Classes may be added up to 2 hours before the class (no post entry fee will apply if the horse was registered prior to **July 30, 2018.**) Announcements will be made at the show for entry cutoffs. Regular entry fees apply to all added classes. “Add Forms” must be filled out at the show office. No additions will be accepted without the completed form. **Scratches:** After **July 30, 2018** to prior to the start of the show – scratches will be accepted for a full refund only with a veterinary certificate. Once the show commences, scratches will be also accepted at the show office, however no refund will be issued unless a veterinary certificate is provided at the show to the show office.
6. In cases of classes with posted order of performance, any horse missing its turn will be eliminated from that class unless otherwise arranged in advance. A working order may be drawn for all individual work classes including Halter. Use of working orders will be at show managements discretion.
7. A \$50 NSF charge will be charged on all cheques not honored and failure to clear the debt promptly may result in suspension from the ApHC.
8. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will allow their horses to be tested.
9. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** Original papers or current photocopy (front & back) must be presented with all entries. Master registration form must show owner exactly as listed on the papers. Non pro and Youth exhibitors must produce registration papers showing ownership or proving approved relationship to the owner.
10. **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** Every person competing in an AHAA approved show must possess a current membership card for their points to count for the AHAA year end awards. If the exhibitor wishes to enter the ApHC approved classes they must possess a current individual ApHC membership card, or ApHC membership card with Non Pro/Youth privileges, recorded solely in their name, or must complete a membership application and pay at the show, which will be submitted with the show roster. Show management must inspect this membership card or photocopy of it at any show the exhibitor has entered.
11. **EXHIBITOR NUMBERS:** Each horse will be issued an exhibitor number at the show.
12. **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:** When an exhibitor, owner and/or his representative acting on behalf of the exhibitor is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of a horse while on the show grounds, the Show management, at its sole discretion, may suspend such individual(s) from competition and a report will be forwarded to ApHC. No refund of entry fees will be made.
13. Youth or Non Pro classes will automatically be combined if there is not a point class in 1 division. The classes that are combined will be run at the time the Youth/ Non pro classes would be scheduled
14. **HIGH POINT AWARDS:** In order to qualify for a high point award exhibitors must show to all judges. Points will be tabulated throughout the show. See above entry form for information on awards and awards tabulations. (Ties will be decided by the participant with the most 1st place achievements)
15. Haul in/grounds fee will be applied to those horses that are not stabled at the event. See above entry form for more info.
16. **RV PARKING:** See online entry form for more information.

17. ARENA USE: The indoor arena and wash rack will be available for use on Friday evening.
18. (See ApHC Rule Book for more information) In order to be eligible to show in novice non-pro classes, the non-pro must have fewer than 20 points (including points earned in non-pro, novicenon-pro, 35 & over non-pro, masters non-pro, youth and novice youth divisions) in that class in the ApHC and/or any other breed association as of January 1 of the current year and must not have won an ApHC non-pro National or World title or title in any other equine breed association (ie: ApHCC, AQHA, APHA) in that class (beginning 1/1/1996). In addition, **former professionals reclassified as non-pros are ineligible to compete in any novice classes.**

To be eligible to show in a novice youth class, the youth, as of January 1 of the current year, shall have earned less than a combined total of 20 points in the ApHC and/or any other breed organization –approved or –sponsored shows in the group of youth and novice youth classes that count toward determining novice eligibility in each of the five novice youth classes, excluding walk-trot, leadline, hunter in hand and halter. The youth must not have won an ApHC youth National or World title or title in any other equine breed association (ie: ApHCC, AQHA, APHA) (beginning 1/1/1998) in that class to remain eligible. Youth may be ineligible for one class (based on points or titles earned) but may still be eligible to compete in other novice youth classes.

- If you are showing in NOVICE classes you **must** provide a copy of your **verified eligibility** to the show management.
